Letter from Cllr. Gregory Stafford, Leader of the Conservative Group

Dear Ealing North Member,

Thank you for your continued support of the Conservative Party both nationally and locally. The Conservative national victory was an amazing feat and we've already begun to see the benefits of having a majority Conservative government unfettered by the Liberal Democrats. Nationally Labour is imploding with the election of Corbyn. Locally, Ealing Labour Councillors are very jumpy at the moment, frightened that they might be deselected in they are not left-wing enough.



On the Council, we continue to challenge them both in terms of their ideology of raising taxes via hidden charges (garden waste, parking etc) and in terms of their poor delivery of services locally (dirty streets, our roads in disrepair).

One of our biggest campaigns has been around the imposition by the Council to us all of wheelie bins and fortnightly collections.
